
GRAPHIC VIEW OF SPECIALISATION WISE SEGREGATION








Graphical View of First Year Students

Bringing out the best in you- Lockdown and placements at ADMIFMS, University of Mumbai

The year 2020 is not the same year as compared to many other previous years. The pandemic challenge has impacted everyone. It has impacted lives, health, family, society, and placements too. Many organizations laid off their employees, withdrew the offers, cancelled students summer internships, and offers. The Institute also faced the same challenge. For us, it was a challenging time and we were equally in dilemma to resolve this. But, ADMIFMS is known to deal with challenges and emerge victoriously.

The Placement Committee of the institute has taken the responsibility to fulfill the commitment for providing corporate exposure to students. We revamped the strategy and started tapping organizations for digital internships. We were elated to receive a positive response from corporate and with their support, we achieved 100 percent summer internship completion with stipends for many students. Apart from securing 100 percent summer placements, many of the students performed exceptionally well in their internship and received an appreciation letter from their mentors. Ms. Vaidehi Vihari was awarded among the top 100 students for her Summer internship project, by E4 development and Coaching limited. Students of M.Sc. Finance, a new programme launched at the institute in 2019-20, also secured 100 percent summer internships. Our placement officer Ms. Kavita Mishra Pandey was awarded by YUGMA – Unsung Heroes Awards 2020 for her outstanding contribution and persistent efforts in shaping students' careers.

Dr. Smita Shukla, In-charge Director, highlights that:-

'Challenges faced by the Placement Cell during a pandemic are unique. Pandemic is a black swan event. No background work or experience can be applied to deal with this unique and once-in-a-lifetime event. What makes us proud as an institution is a way the Placement Cell rose up to the challenge. Right in the initial first month of the start of lockdown (March-April 2020), the Institution had decided against opting for in-house summer internship projects. We felt that such in-house projects would not provide the students with actual market experience and company rigour. The placement cell was asked to explore online summer placement and final opportunities with regular partner companies and to look beyond them if required. The placement cell not only succeeded in ensuring 100% summer placement opportunities for the students but also secured several summer internship opportunities with stipend. Several students, in fact, used the lockdown period gainfully by doing more than one internship project. The momentum for the final placements was also well maintained and was successful in spite of the testing time'.


