THE ALMA - MENTOR PROGRAM

Mentoring, a long-standing custom, involves supporting, encouraging, and giving advice to someone who has less experience with the goal of helping them to advance in their career. The mentoring concept is as old as human race; every student has a mentor as we can see many instances in our mythology where a mentor helps his/ her mentee to realize and attain their full potential.

Mentoring is not a new concept in India. A lot of examples can be drawn from mythology. In Ramayana, we hear about Hanuman who was motivated by Jambavant to fly across the sea. In Mahabharata, Krishna mentored Arjuna. Bhagavad Gita, India's unique contribution to the world is more than mentoring. In the Indian history, many of the leaders were groomed by their mentors, for example, Chandragupta Maurya by Kautilya (Chanakya), Swami Vivekananda by Ramakrishna Paramahamsa, and Pandit Nehru by Mahatma Gandhi and so on. Ancient knowledge and skills were passed on from one generation to other by mentoring.

The major goal of this event was to close the gap between the eager students and the business community. The enormous potential of youthful, energizing minds that are awakened always tends to be organized and given a direction. It was extremely important to appoint a mentor whom the students could feel comfortable with the goal of personalized grooming and personal aid in student's developement; comfortability in getting acquainted with his or her traits, areas of growth, and resources for prep material.
